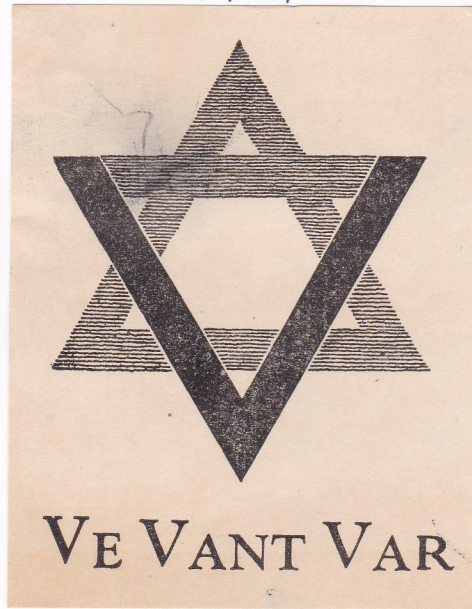

fulness over a sick and wounded world like a Good Samaritan.

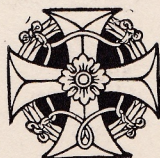
Not in splendid isolation, but in courageous coöperation.

peoples, but in sympathy, love, and understanding.

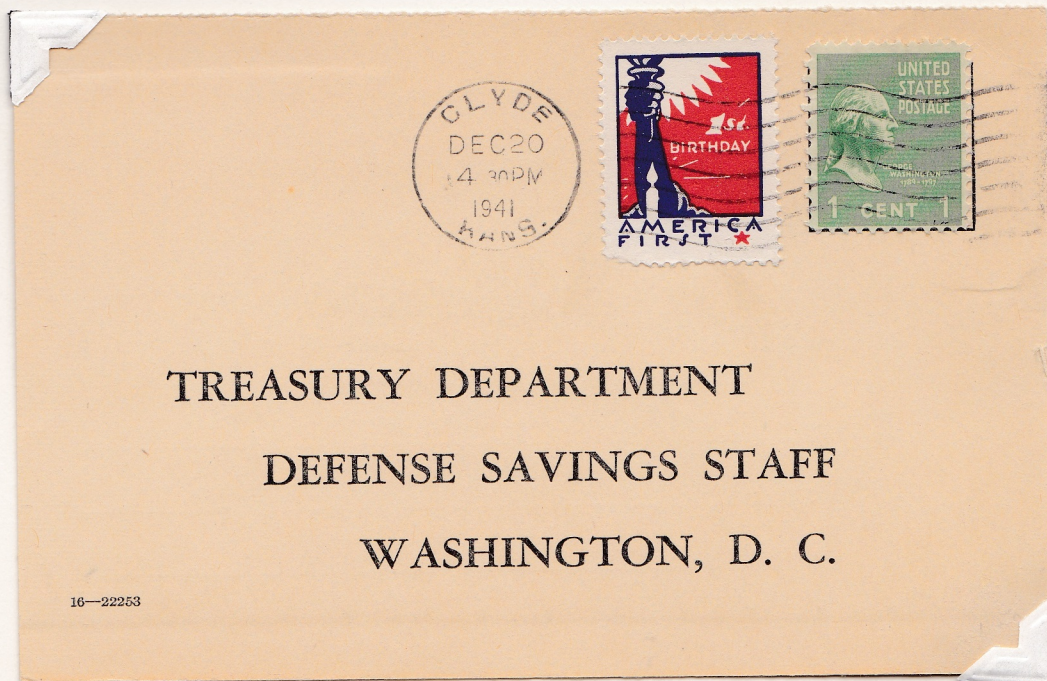
Not in treading again the old, worn, bloody pathway
